These items should not be flushed down the toilet:

- Fats, Oils & Greases
- Dental Floss
- Non-flushable Wipes
- Flushable Wipes
- Baby Diapers
- Adult Diapers
- Feminine Hygiene Products
- Condoms
- Paper Towels
- Photographic Solutions
- Cigarette Butts
- Coffee Grounds
- Cat Litter
- Pharmaceuticals
- Hair Weave Extensions
- Household Chemicals like gasoline, oil, pesticides, antifreeze, paint and paint thinners



Flush That!

Ideally, the sewer system should handle only:

- Human Waste
- Toilet Paper
- Water

Some Things Are Not!

Many sanitary products such as: **DENTAL FLOSS, NON-DEGRADABLE WIPES, FEMININE HYGIENE PRODUCTS, AND DIAPERS** are sometimes flushed down the toilet. These items can cause major mechanical problems in the sewer system and lead to basement back-ups and sewer overflows. The proper disposal of these products is placement in the trash, not the toilet.
